Questions for Reflection

As Christians we have the privilege and the command from our Lord to tell others about salvation through Jesus.

What fears or concerns often keep you from being a confident witness?

What application do the following passages have for you to help become a more confident witness for Jesus?

He who listens to you listens to me; he who rejects you rejects me; but he who rejects me rejects him who sent me (Luke 10:16).

Do not worry about what to say or how to say it. At that time you will be given what to say, for it will not be you speaking, but the Spirit of your Father speaking through you (Matthew 10:19-20).
