Order of Worship for K-8 (or PreK-8 if joint) Sundays after Pentecost - Year B - 2023-24

This order of service can work for the entire Pentecost Season, but is particularly designed to work with Holy Trinity Sunday through the Sixth Sunday after Pentecost (and The Foundation series "A Top-Down Faith").

If using for a PreK-8 joint service, consider using the PreK version of the psalm, so your non-readers may more easily participate with the psalm.
