### *The Service—Setting Five for Christian Worship*

Previously planned as one of the musical settings of The Service with Holy Communion in *Christian Worship*, **The Service—Setting Five** is now available for purchase and use. To watch demo videos of the entire setting, [go HERE](#).

When selecting “Order of Service” in the Service Plan window, users of *Christian Worship: Service Builder (CW:SB)* will now find available The Service—Setting Five. This new setting rounds off the liturgical settings planned by the WELS Hymnal Project. As with all the other settings of The Service with Holy Communion in *CW:SB*, The Service—Setting Five is fully resourced with music graphics for all the canticles, inclusion of both the seasonal and all of the proper verse Gospel Acclamations across all lectionaries, sample melody lines for audition, and automatic background reprint reporting to OneLicense. Use of The Service—Setting Five in *CW:SB* comes with no additional subscription cost. (Congregations that do not have a keyboardist can purchase the *CW:SB* Playlist module to provide playback of downloadable MP3 files for music in *CW:SB*, including The Service—Setting Five.)

- The *Keyboard Accompaniment Edition* (in E and E $\flat$ ) includes the full liturgical text as well as all the Gospel Acclamations for the Three-Year, One-Year, Minor Festivals, and Occasions lectionaries.
- The edition entitled *Liturgical Ensemble* (in E and E $\flat$ ) provides additional options of guitar, bass guitar, vocal harmony and descants, and C and B $\flat$  instruments.
