National Hymnal Week: Hymn Sing Outline

Our video-based hymn sing follows the life of Christ through the seasons of the church year. Led by choirs of students from Martin Luther College and Luther Preparatory School and a children's choir from Christ the Lord in Brookfield, Wisconsin, we'll sing hymns both old and new from Advent, Christmas, Epiphany, Lent, and Easter. Psalms from Lent and Easter will help us dwell a bit longer on Christ's death and resurrection. These are *Songs from the Spirit*, gospel words God uses to raise the dead and to fill our hearts and our lives with praise.

- Reprinting of the copyrighted text and music requires that your congregation have a reprint license (such as [OneLicense](#)) and that you report accordingly.
- The hymn sing is being produced in the form of a pre-recorded video, which will be made available online for anyone to watch. Those listening and watching are invited to sing along with the choirs in the video, so the video will work best in a group setting. Congregations might consider using the hymn sing video in place of Sunday Bible class on September 19.
- If you're planning a watch party, you'll want to make sure that you have a sound system that can support the singing of whatever sized group you hope to gather. People will need to be able to hear the sound of the video while they sing along with it.
