A Time to be Born and a Time to Die

Readings:

Acts 13:26-39

David served his purpose in his generation, so do we, but it's all part of God's big plan that he carries out through his Holy One.

Psalm 16

Psalm 16 connects to Acts 13 and emphasizes that because Jesus knew the path of eternal life, we know true life through him. We believe that when God carries out his purpose for us in Jesus, that "the boundary lines have fallen for me in pleasant places."

Galatians 6:7-10 (Sermon text)

Our life is like a seed-sowing project. We will reap what we sow. We don't live for the moment. We sow in the Spirit to reap eternal life from the Spirit—and that fruit will come at the appointed time. So, as we have opportunity, as we have time, we do good!

Get behind me Satan—Take up your cross. Jesus' eternal perspective changes how we view everything.
