We have a holy God. He<br>wants us to live a holy life, one that is wholly dedicated to<br>him, one that is spiritually and emotionally healthy for us.<br>So, as Jesus continues his Sermon on the Mount, he makes a<br>crucial point that not all his followers (including present-day<br>followers) understand well. Jesus came to free us <u>from</u> sin.<br>He did not come to free us <u>to</u> sin. God commands that we<br>live a holy life. He provides dire warnings to remind us just<br>how holy he wants us to be. Today we face a rapid decline<br>in public morals and private piety. Yet, Jesus calls his<br>followers to be different. He urges personal purity.<br>After examining our lives, we can only despair over our lack<br>of holiness. So, the Gospel Acclamation reminds us to flee<br>to Christ who loves us despite our failures and who<br>sacrificed himself for unholy people.
